The posting:

It's with many tears we are looking for a home for our two rescue dogs. They are small in size. One is a Springer Spaniel/Border Collie mix. She is very intelligent.

The other is a mixture also looks most like a dashund. Not so clever. Bit of a dizzy blond.

In the past my wife and I have done volunteer building work for a charity and have been asked to do so again. We are unable to bring pets for this and the term is 5 years. It is for this reason we are looking for a new home for our surrogate babies.

They are fully house trained, micro chipped, vaccinated and registered. They don't require long walks, and being rescue the small one is shy but once he settles in gives loads of kisses. We love them very much we are only giving them to the right person, they have to go together.



We will supply their beds, frontline and food for some time so there will no expense for the new owners. If their new home turns out to be in the UK, we would help with the transports costs. This is how much we love them.

Cancer patient's brave cycle ride

Julian Buckland, a recovering cancer patient has just completed a three-day east to west solo cycle ride across Cyprus to raise about €2,500 for The Friends' Hospice in Paphos.

He began his mountain bike journey on Friday near Cape Apostolos Andreas at the eastern most tip of the island's panhandle and completed the journey on Sunday afternoon at Paphos Harbour. The trip took him first to Kyrenia and then to Polis before his descent across the Akamas to Peyia and onwards to Kato Paphos.

Altogether he covered 360 kilometres, sometimes averaging speeds of 30 kilometres an hour on the bike loaned to him by the Easy Ride shop in Paphos.

Julian says: "The worst part of the journey was on Saturday, when I was caught in almost non-stop torrential rain. At times visibility was down to 10 metres. That same rain resulted in enormous problems for the traversing of the Akamas peninsula. It turned the whole area into a sea of red mud making it really hard to peddle through."

Julian, known to his friends as 'J', had a kidney removed a few months ago when a small routine operation revealed a cancerous tumour. He said: "It was a real shock. I had no idea I had cancer. There was no illness, no sign whatsoever. I went into a real dark mental hole when I was given the news. A friend of mine who also suffered from cancer was on the support committee of The Friends' Hospice so, I decided I would try to raise some money to help them in the good work they do for the community."

Fortunately, 'J' had always kept himself fit from his years in the British Army so, his recovery period was shorter and easier that might have been expected after such a major medical procedure.

His wife, Josephine ('José') and friends formed a support team for the arduous cycle ride accompanying 'J' in motor vehicles along the journey to ensure he did not need medical assistance and that he remained hydrated and properly nourished with highprotein meals and snacks.

Crowds of well-wishers and tourists gathered at the harbour on Sunday to cheer him along the last part of his east-west trip across the island.

A native of Charlton Mackrell near Somerton in Somerset, 'J' served as an avionics engineer in the forces, supporting the helicopters of the Army's Air Corps. Afterwards he spent seventeen years in Saudi Arabia.

The money raised was by family members and through public sponsorship at the Hospice's four charity shops.

Matt, despite being a boxer and physically fit had in fact never run further than 5km before and Alan completed the half marathon in a quicker time than last year. To add an extra twist to proceedings and to give people a further reason to put their hands in their pockets, Lee donned a pirate costume and completed all 4 days in the fancy dress outfit. The fantastic sponsorship he received was a definite spur to keep Lee on track and determined to succeed.

None of them can be termed 'racing snakes' and it certainly was a challenge for them.

Day 1 - Was a nice 'easy' start a 6.1km time trial run from Coral Beach hotel to the 'new' shipwreck at Sea Caves. It was run on a

time trial basis leaving in alphabetical order, 10 seconds apart from each other which meant being disciplined on how fast you were running and not to use too much effort catching the man (or lady) in front. Of course being chivalrous they let plenty of people pass them.



Day 2 - Was a hill run of 11km. The race started at sea level by the Last Castle and continued on the loose gravel track. The rains of the previous weeks had softened up the tracks and they even had to circumvent a stuck car. The finish was at the village square of Pano Arodes and even the Priest popped out to say hello and wish them well. A final gain of altitude of over 600m (1800ft). It was very tough and proved to be Matt's hardest day. They perked

up when fellow MOPED members proffered them with ale with half a mile to go.

Day 3 - The half marathon 22km and for Lee the hardest day, not just because of the distance, but the legs were suffering from the previous day's efforts. The day started at Neo Chorio near Latchi, climbing up approximately 900ft over the first 11km through a very windy Akamas to the radio masts at Ineia before a steep rough terrain descent of approximately 1600ft down to sea level at Lara bay and the last couple of kilometres across to Toxeftra Beach (in front of Last Castle). The wind and rain started at the 6km point and lasted until they ascended to the highest point, not the most pleasant of runs!

The final day - and one to celebrate - the 10km (6.2 miles) run from Paphos harbour down to Geriskipou and return, ending in front of Paphos castle. They must have smelt the free Keo on tap at the finish as they both had an excellent run.



Lee, Matt and Alan are all of differing ages, shapes and sizes and met through an informal social group known as the MOPED club. The club has taken on the Friend's Hospice and CPSG as their adoptive charities this year and Lee, Matt and Alan together with the rest of the 20 members will be

doing their best to raise funds for these extremely good causes.

The competition was very well organised and our thanks to the many local volunteer marshals for a job well done. 179 runners started and 169 finished and not one of the three Mopeds were last in any of the events which actually means some of the sponsors owe the charity even more money!

Not sure of the total amount raised from completing the 4 day challenge as yet, but certainly at time of writing, by running in fancy dress Lee has raised over €1,300 for the Friends' Hospice and CPSG, which is absolutely fabulous. Thanks to everyone that has supported with their generous donations and sponsorship, it certainly made a difference knowing you just can't give up!







The rates of return on deposit accounts have, at the best of times, struggled to keep pace with inflation and this has never been truer than now, with rising inflation and historically low interest rates, whether Euros or Sterling. If you study the UK comparison sites, they show that, at time of writing, you can achieve a UK rate of interest, for an instant access bank/building society savings







account with no catches, of around 1% - 1.5%. It doesn't seem that long ago that Cyprus banks were offering over three and four times the rates of their UK counterparts. Unfortunately, many people are now counting the cost of having complete trust in the 'safety' of Cyprus banks, including Laiki and Bank of Cyprus.

We have been recommending to our clients for a number of years that one should not deposit more than the depositor protection scheme (DPS) allows, presently €100k. Fortunately, our clients heeded our proactive approach. Deposit accounts have traditionally been regarded as a safe haven although offering a low return, as risk and reward generally go hand in hand, but, as we have seen over the last year, a 'low' risk bank deposit does not mean 'no' risk.

UK base lending interest rates have once again been kept at a record low of 0.5% (November 2014) by the Bank of England's Monetary Policy Committee. The latest Bank of England inflation report suggests that the first hike in interest rates, from 0.50% to 0.75%, is currently more likely to occur next autumn or even later, rather than around mid-2015, according to Howard Archer, of analysts IHS Global Insight.

It is the 66th straight month that the Bank of England has left rates unchanged. The effects of inflation and the potential impairment it can have on your savings should also not be underestimated. An inflation rate of 2.5% would mean a UK basic rate taxpayer requires an interest rate of 3.13% for their savings to keep up with inflation, a higher rate UK taxpayer would need a rate of 4.17% and an additional rate taxpayer would require 5%. It is predicted that UK inflation will rise to 3% and this small increase will have the effect of increasing those required savings rates to 3.75%/5%/6%, respectively.

Your garden this month

I bought my Christmas cards recently and this year instead of glittery holly or Edwardian skating scenes, there is a jolly snowman with a long carrot nose surrounded by cheery red breasted robins on the branches behind him. I wonder why we associate red with Christmas. It's maybe because it such a bright colour in the depths of winter to cheer us up when all around us in the garden is resting again. Or it may be that it is the colour of Santa's robes, although at one time he wore green. Red and green are opposites on the colour circle and are regarded by those who know as harmonious. If you look around you will see the other opposites, purple and yellow, and blue and orange. A wonderful illustration of harmonious colouring in plants is the strelitzia plant which may be in flower or coming into flower in your garden now. In my colder garden I don't have that joy until much later, when the weather starts to warm up. So in all the garden centres there will be plenty of harmony this month as poinsettias, anthuriums and cyclamen all vie for your attention with their various red flowers and green foliage.

Poinsettias have several common and appropriate names around the world such as 'Christmas Stars', 'Flower of the Holy Night', 'Flame Leaf' and 'Short Day Plant'. The actual poinsettia flower is the tiny yellow growth right in the centre of those lovely bright red or now sometimes cream or pink bracts known as modified leaves. Coming originally from Mexico they can find

our winter temperatures somewhat alien. We have draughts and hot and cold temperatures all of which they don't cope with very well. I cringe when I see them in displays on shop fronts knowing that their days are numbered. They don't like window sills either, so it's lucky that not many houses in Cyprus have them. The first Christmas I was here I tried putting them on the porch in wicker baskets but they were subjected to the vagaries of the weather, so now I keep them indoors in a bright place and cosset them a little. After Christmas they are usually consigned to our summer indoor sitting room downstairs with other pot plants and if they sprout new bracts then all well and good. They don't like too much handling and if a stem breaks off then you will have a milky sap flowing from the break, which can be an irritant to sensitive skins. Some times people find watering a problem as these plants don't like to be too wet. If you feel the soil and it is dry then hold the plant over a bowl and let water run it through until it stops.

Outside my favourite nerines will be flowering until nearer Christmas, unless we have storms. They are quite delicate plants but can stand our very hot summers as they are semi-dormant then. Then just as the days are getting shorter they throw up these beautiful flower heads to brighten up our days. In the UK they are late summer flowerers and like to be planted at the foot of a south facing wall. A friend gave me some lovely semi-wild cyclamen when he moved house last year and I planted them around the edge of the centre bed in the front garden and their beautifully patterned leaves are growing steadily. I like them better than the potted ones which are in many garden centres at this time of year. Years ago I planted several tiny cyclamen under a big thuja tree in

the front garden, but sadly the cats from next door have scratched up many of them. However they seed themselves everywhere so maybe I will be able to enjoy some later.

This month despite all the preparations for the festive season have a look at your fruit and nut trees. By now pecans and figs should have lost their leaves and can be pruned carefully. If you don't prune pecans they can put enormous growth and you will not able to pick the delicious nuts. So keep them to a reasonable height and you will be able to collect them before the crows get to them next year. As the citrus start to colour up they will attract the Mediterranean fruit flies, all except lemons and limes whose skins seem to be too tough for them. All the fruiting trees need a feed now after all the dry weather they have endured since they were last fed in May. The rain will help to spread it into the ground where it will do most good. Remember that the feeding roots are not around the trunk area but spread between the trunk and the tree canopy, so that is where you should be putting the fertiliser -900 gms of 21.0.0 or 20.10.10 for mature trees and 300 gms for young trees. Almost all fertilisers come in bags or cartons and have the numbers printed on the sides NPK - Nitrogen, Phosphorus and Potassium - all vital for good fruits, roots and healthy trees.

If you grow your own winter veggies than you can expect a good crop of cabbage, sprouts, broccoli or Kohl rabi for your Christmas dinner. You may also have a few salad plants growing well especially if you live along the coast. A friend of mine built himself a greenhouse using empty St Nicholas water bottles, which because the bottles are square fitted snugly together. He



made frames for the sides and roof and threaded the bottles onto long bamboo canes. He attached them to the frame and built the walls. Adding a door and opening windows, he has the ideal place to grow salads during the colder season and the shelves contain seed trays to bring on plants for when the weather turns warm again. I think he is brilliant.

Flower that was used to wipe out wolves and whales

A gardener who worked at a businessman's GBP4million estate in the UK collapsed and died after apparently handling a highly poisonous plant known as Devil's Helmet.

- Aconitum is known as Devil's Helmet or monkshood because its petals resemble a drooping hood.
- It is also called wolfsbane or mousebane because its poison was once used to kill wolves and vermin.
- The plant contains the toxin aconitine which causes severe vomiting, dizziness and diarrhoea if digested.
- It is rarely eaten accidentally because its bitter taste leaves a burning and numbing sensation in the mouth.
- The poison slows the heart rate, causing paralysis of the heart and respiratory centre.
- In Shakespeare's Henry IV, the king makes reference to 'venom of suggestion' which has the force of 'aconitum or rash gunpowder'.
- In 2009, 'Curry Killer' Lakhvir Singh, of Southall, West London, poisoned her ex-lover and his fiancée with a curry laced with Indian aconite. Her ex-lover died and his fiancée survived only because she had eaten less curry. Singh was jailed for life.
- In 2004, the plant killed a Canadian actor who ate it on a camping trip believing it to be wild parsnip.
- Aconitum was used by the aboriginals of the Kamchatka peninsula in the Pacific Ocean to poison whales by lacing a harpoon with its toxin.
- In ancient China, the poison was smeared on arrows, including the shaft, so that the weapon would kill its victim as well as anyone who tried to pull the arrow from the wound.

The secret behind Pippa's prim posterior

It is the derriere that captivated the country at her sister's wedding. Now Pippa Middleton has decided to share the secret of how she achieves her toned behind - and keeps it in shape. The answer is a simple 30-mintue total body workout that includes 'plié squats'.

The 31-year-old - dubbed Her Royal Hotness ever since the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge's wedding in 2011 - has been given a monthly column in Waitrose Weekend Magazine in which to share her diet and exercise tips.

She already writes for the supermarket's food publication Waitrose Kitchen and now plans to share her 'personal philosophy of healthy eating and exercise'.

She swears by four key exercises - ladders, plié squats, wall pushes and the 'classic plank' - that are 'quick and great for toning all over'. Each exercise takes around two minutes to perform, and she recommends a 30 second break between the moves with a two minute rest at the end of each circuit.

For those who are keen to emulate Miss Middleton's famous behind, the squat and the plank will be of most interest as they are designed to strengthen and trim the gluteal muscles that make up the buttocks.



The four simple steps she swears by:

Ladders

A great cardio move that will increase your heart rate.

Jogging on the spot, lift each knee as high as you can while raising the opposite arm in the air (A). Continue alternating (B) for two minutes.

Wall Push

Use this as a 'starter' push-up to work chest and arms.

Place your hands flat on a wall, arms straight, wrists at shoulder height (A). Bend your elbows bringing your face close to the wall (B), then push back. Do 8-12 reps.

One of the best moves for core strength and flat abs.



so can they fully understand what it is like to live here and cope with the local bureaucracy and have a deep understanding of the financial planning needs of expatriates and the Cyprus tax regime.

Laing & Buisson recently reported that the total UK elderly healthcare market will be worth £26bn by 2015. Ageing is a global trend with the number of people aged 85 and over in 2013 being 1.6m in the UK (www.parliament.uk). This is set to almost double during the next 20 years. Today UK tax payers spend 0.5% of GDP on care for older people in England and in Age UK's view this needs to increase to 0.9% of GDP by 2020.



Throughout 2014, thus far, one of the major reasons for the pound's strong performance has been the expectation of a rate rise at some point during the year. November turned out to be a tough month for those holding pounds as expectations of any rate increase has now been pushed well back into 2015, and potentially even 2016. The recent inflation report from the UK was the main contributor in this downfall as Bank of England



Governor, Mark Carney, suggested inflation could fall below 1% and would most likely fail to reach the 2% target for the next three years. This resulted in the Sterling losing over 3 cents versus the euro in the space of a week, which is the largest fall in this time period for over two-and-a-half years. This was further compounded by news that the eurozone's biggest economy, Germany, had avoided recession, strengthening the euro further versus the beleaguered pound.

Towards the end of the month the euro's fortunes started to wane, however, as European Central Bank (ECB) Chief, Mario Draghi, did his best to drag the single currency lower. During a key speech in Frankfurt, Draghi announced that the ECB will start purchasing asset-backed securities (ABS), expanding its quantitative easing regime as inflation expectations for the eurozone continue to fall. The ABS purchases are the second installment in the ECB's mission to spur growth by expanding its balance sheet. In September, the Central Bank began buying covered corporate bonds, which are guaranteed against a company's assets and expect both these asset purchases to last for two years at least. Most market participants believe, however, that these measures aren't enough and Mario Draghi in his speech hinted that he may be in agreement by stating that he felt it essential to bring inflation back to target without delay. This was seen as a likely signal that the ECB will extend its asset purchase programme to include an all-out quantitative easing (QE) programme, involving the bulk purchasing of sovereign debt sooner rather than later. Some analysts are now predicting that this could even commence before the turn of the year.

Looking at the remainder of the year, the markets will be very much focused on how UK data effects potential rate rises next year and also whether or not the ECB starts a full scale QE programme. Any data releases or comments surrounding these two major issues will be seized on as investors try to piece together the clues for likely market direction. This is likely to bring about increased volatility in the market place as we enter the final period of 2014.



The trailer can be delivered to almost any location in the Paphos area, and is quick and easy to set up wherever it is needed - just requiring to be within 30 metres of a 13-amp socket.



Supper cuppas

Do you think making a chicken stew with dumplings or chocolate chip muffins from scratch will leave your kitchen in tatters? Think again. A new book, Meal in a Mug, has more than 70 recipes, all of which can be prepared in minutes and cooked in, well, a mug.

Here are some of the tastiest.

Berry Crumble

Ingredients:

125g mixed frozen berries

1 tsp soft brown sugar

1 tsp cornflour

For the crumble:

4 tbsp whole rolled porridge oats

2 tsp brown sugar

1/4 tsp ground cinnamon

1 tsp butter, melted

Method: put the berries in a 150ml microwavable mug - they should almost come to the top.

- sprinkle the sugar and cornflour over them and microwave on high for 30 seconds. Stir gently so you don't break the berries, the microwave on high for another 30 seconds, or until the sauce starts to thicken.
- put the oats in a small bowl and stir in all the remaining topping ingredients. Spoon the crumble over the berries and stand the cup in a shallow microwaveable bowl, in case any of the sauce bubbles over.
- microwave on high for one minute 20 seconds.
- allow to stand for one minute before serving with a scoop of vanilla ice cream or custard

Chicken Stew with herb dumplings

Ingredients:

2 tbsp chopped onion

1 small carrot and 1 small potato, peeled, chopped into 1cm pieces

2-3 tbsp hot chicken stock

2 tsp chicken gravy granules

Handful shredded cooked chicken

Pinch of dried mixed herbs

For the dumplings:

1 tbsp suet

2 tbsp self-raising flour

1/2 tsp dried mixed herbs

4 tsp water

Method: put veg in a 500ml microwaveable mug.

- add 100ml of the stock and stand mug in a shallow microwayeable dish.
- cover with cling film, pierce film with a knife.
- cook on high for two minutes
- remove, stir, re-cover and cook on high for two minutes.
- meanwhile mix dumpling ingredients in a small mug, stir remaining stock, gravy granules, chicken and herbs into the veg in the mug.
- using a spoon, divide the dumpling mixture into two and dollop both on top of the stew.
- cover again, microwave on high for one minute, or until

dumplings are just set.

- allow to stand for two to three minutes before serving.

Choc-Chip Muffins

Ingredients:

4 tbsp self-raising flour

4 tbsp soft light brown sugar

1 tbsp cocoa powder

2 tbsp lightly whisked egg white

1/2 tsp vanilla extract

3 tbsp milk

3 tbsp sunflower oil

3 tbsp chocolate chips

Method: put two paper muffin cases in the base of two 200ml microwaveable coffee cups, or line them with parchment paper.

- in a small bowl or jug, mix together the flour, sugar, cocoa powder, egg white, vanilla extract and 1 tbsp of the milk to make a smooth paste.
- stir in the remaining milk, all the oil and 2 tbsp of the chocolate chips.
- divide the chocolate mixture between the two cases, then sprinkle the top with the remaining chocolate chips.
- microwave on high for three minutes.
- remove and allow to stand for one minute before serving.

Cheesy Nachos

Ingredients:

12 plain flavor tortilla chips

2-3 tbsp tomato salsa

2 tbsp grated cheese

6 sliced jalapeno peppers

To serve:

Soured cream and/or guacamole

Method: layer about six tortilla chips in the base and sides of a 300ml microwaveable coffee cup.

- spoon over 1 tbsp of salsa, 1 tbsp of grated cheese and a few jalapenos, then repeat the layers, finishing with the cheese.
- microwave on high for one minute
- serve topped with a little soured cream and/or guacamole

Chocolate Orange Pudding

Ingredients:

1 slice white bread, crusts removed

Softened butter for spreading

6 pieces of dark chocolate, roughly chopped

1 eac

2 tbsp caster sugar

Grated rind of one orange

100ml milk

Method: spread the bread with the butter, then cut it into squares. Arrange in the bottom of a 300ml microwaveable coffee cup.

- add the chocolate pieces, nestling them among the pieces of bread.
- in a small bowl or jug, whisk together the egg, sugar, orange zest and milk, until the sugar has dissolved.
- pour this over the bread mixture.
- microwave on high for about one minute 50 seconds, or until just set. Allow to stand for one minute before serving.
