



RAF Tornado jets fly missions from Akrotiri

British RAF jets armed with missiles have begun to fly their first mission over Iraq after Parliament voted to begin air strikes on Isis targets.



Tornado GR4 fighter bombers based at RAF Akrotiri in Cyprus are supported by a Voyager air-to-air refuelling aircraft. The Ministry of Defence said the jets will carry out armed reconnaissance operations and that intelligence gathered would be "invaluable".

The jets were ready for attack should "an appropriate target" have been identified, according to the MoD.

The MoD said in a statement: "We can confirm that, following parliamentary approval, RAF Tornados continue to fly over Iraq and are now ready to be used in an attack role as and when appropriate targets are identified.

"For operational security reasons we will not be providing a running commentary on movements; we will provide an update on activity when it is appropriate to do so."

Six Tornado jets have been based on Cyprus since August but had been restricted to reconnaissance flights.

The RAF also has a Rivet Joint spy plane in the region which is stepping up surveillance efforts to identify potential targets, while intelligence will also be sought from Iraqi and Kurdish forces on the ground.

The Commons voted by 524 to 43 to approve intervention in Iraq to counter the advance of Isis militants across swathes of the country.

If you are seeking culture, history, nature and the beach, then look no further than Sri Lanka.

Lonely Planet introduces Sri Lanka with 'endless beaches, timeless ruins, welcoming people, oodles of elephants, killer surf, cheap prices, fun trains, famous tea, flavourful food - need we go on?'

You can fly from Cyprus with Etihad, Emirates or Qatar Airways, via Abu Dhabi, Dubai and Doha respectively, so plenty of choice of stopovers if you wish to combine a stay in Sri Lanka with a city break en-route. 

A tribute of songs In memory of World War One 1914 - 1918

One hundred years ago, Europe and her allies were embroiled in the tragedy of the Great War. Over the last few months there have been many solemn ceremonies held to honour those who died, remembering the great sacrifices that were made and vowing that they would never be forgotten.

Paphos Voices are offering their own tribute by presenting a concert of contrasts. Stirring anthems which mourn the thousands who died but also songs to salute the fortitude of the loved ones left behind.

Beginning with "From the rising of the sun" and "Souls of the righteous", anthems which remember the departed, the mood changes and recalls songs that were being sung early in the century before the war began, including "By the Light of the Silvery Moon", "Alexander's Ragtime Band" and perhaps surprisingly, "The Londonderry Air". Following these is a medley of tongue-in-cheek ditties and parodies sung defiantly by the front-line troops to bolster their morale, some versions with words quite unprintable but also including the "no man's land" carol "Stille Nacht" (Silent Night) and ending with the evocative "Home Sweet Home".

After the interval it becomes unashamedly sentimental, focusing on the songs sung to combat the worry and heartache of the waiting families and friends. "It's a Long Way to Tipperary" and "Roses of Picardy" were brought back by the servicemen on leave and rapidly gained popularity along with "Keep the home fires burning", "If you were the only girl in the world" and "Till we meet again". Songs full of desperate hope and longing which can bring a lump to the throat even now. Sir Harry Lauder wrote the words to "Keep right on to the end of the road" immediately after hearing of the death in action of his only son, Captain John

Your garden this month

Patricia Jordan

The summer this year has been difficult for many plants especially after such a dry winter with very little rainfall. We need rain during the winter to dampen the earth deep down allowing the fibrous roots of the plants to seek out the water with which to survive. Our well ran dry quite early despite taking care of it and only watering every second day, giving it chance to refill between times. Annuals, with very shallow roots, soon succumbed to the lack of rainfall, which meant that they keeled over without yielding the bounteous crop of seeds that I usually share with other gardeners.

Having consulted a rainfall chart on the web to see what the average rainfall would be in October, it was only one day! Average high temperatures range between 24C and 28C so we are not out of the woods yet. One of my favourite weather stations is BBC Nicosia and I assiduously click the days to see if any rainfall is coming along the Med. Most of any available rain seems to fall to the north of us bypassing our little drought-ridden island. There is far more rain in Greece and the islands than here.

Enough of moaning about the lack of rain, after all we came here to enjoy the many sunny days. However, after a summer like this has been, we really need to rethink our planting and choose plants that can cope with heat, not much rain and lots of

humidity. In our earlier lives we lived in tropical Singapore where the humidity was about 90% nearly all the year and the only difference in the climate were the monsoons which blew past us and up into the Bay of Bengal. We grew the most exotic orchids there and the Singapore Botanic Gardens are still famous for their fabulous collection, in fact the national flower of Singapore is an orchid. We can grow orchids here but they tend to be regarded as indoor pot plants. I visited a huge nursery in the mountains near Vouni a while ago which was just full of them. They also grew anthuriums in many colours. Of course they are grown in temperature controlled conditions, but there is no reason that we couldn't try them in our gardens or verandas.

Neighbouring Malaysia's National Flower is the red hibiscus which grows well here. My under-gardener has managed to keep the mealy bugs at bay by daily patrols with a spray if it became too bad, or just a gloved finger as soon as they appeared. I have seen hedges devastated all over the island by these bugs, which also attack the verbenas that I grow in pots amongst the lavender par terre. Other insects tried to devastate my Pakistani Nights, (Cestrum nocturnum) but my vigilant husband has dealt them a blow too. I grew a huge double yellow datura in a pot but last year the autumn gales blew it over, so with the help of friends we planted in a sheltered place in the garden. However it didn't like the place and died. This plant used to be affected by mealy bugs lying along the stems and under the leaves. I was sorry to lose it, as it was a most striking plant.

Something to look forward to at this time of year is the

appearance of spring bulbs in the garden centres. They arrive from Holland at this time to make our early springtime here so pleasurable. Despite our climate we are able to grow wonderful tulips and daffodils as well as other exotics. Remembering that they will have been packaged for some time always choose firm bulbs and feel them to ensure that they are not rotten anywhere. Don't plant them until the ground is damp or they will not make roots and stabilise.

'Pot Mums' in all their bright jewel-like colours are on the benches too. If you have a blank space in your flower beds pop them in their pots and they will give you autumn colour for a while. Don't buy winter vegetable plugs if they have dried out and certainly don't plant them if the soil is dry. Just be patient and wait a while. October is the traditional time to sow broad beans for early spring cropping before the blackfly are out and about. Cyprus beans are smaller than British broad beans having only 3 or 4 beans per pod but they crop sooner and you are able to enjoy them in the late winter.

Berried shrubs like pyracantha will be sprawling over fence lines looking absolutely gorgeous. Viburnum tinus may be showing its first flowers buds of the autumn. A native of this end of the Mediterranean it is a really good shrub to have in your garden and even makes a good impenetrable hedge. I have cloud pruned a couple of mine bringing lightness to a bed in the orchard. You may find new bright red leaf growth appearing on Photinia 'Red Robin', if you have been pruning it back recently. These Asian origin plants make good hedges and are used extensively in New Zealand as shelter belts from the Antarctic



winds driving up from the south.

Pecan nuts will be ready for picking this month. The crows will also be watching over your trees and know exactly when the outer pod will burst well before you do. When the pods begin to split, collect the nuts removing the outer shell (which may make your hands black) and keep them until Christmas. If you eat them too soon you will find them very soft and not as nice as later on.

About this time I think about replanting my herb garden as most of the plants have gone over. Best survivors are rosemary and lavender but I need chives, basils, mints and parsley to see us through the winter. Most will be available in a garden centre near

- Natural Gas Reserves: Noble Energy has recently discovered substantial gas reserves (5-8 trillion cubic feet) offshore Cyprus which is anticipated to add further impetus to Cyprus's economy with spill-over on positive effects on the real estate sector.



The pot full of holes that's great for plants

It looks like some futuristic car tyre or perhaps a new-fangled fan. But this ingenious inventions is intended for horticultural, not industrial, use.



The Air-Pot is set to revolutionise how we grow our garden plants, its British makers claim. The say it is a clear improvement on the humble flower pot, which has hardly changed in design since first used by the ancient Egyptians.


The Air-Pot is based on the idea that plant roots need aeration to improve the health of flowers and boost fruit and vegetable yields. The plastic containers, made from recycled bottles, are perforated and have undulating surfaces like and egg carton. In a traditional pot, the roots circle round inside, which can lead to the plant becoming pot bound.

But the design of the Air-Pot directs the roots towards the holes. When they reach fresh air, the tips dry out, promoting root growth elsewhere. The design has been used at the Royal Botanic Gardens at Kew and Edinburgh for a decade. Now the Scottish firm behind the pot, the Caledonian Tree Company, is marketing them for amateur gardeners. Marketing director Julyan Rawlings said: "Roots aren't designed to be contained. In the Air-Pot, the holes mean the roots are air-pruned. That encourages root growth, mean healthier plants. It works equally well with chillies, peppers, tomatoes, melons, potatoes - pretty much any plant."



Air-Pots are available online, costing from GBP1.10 for the one-litre version. Tony Kirkham, head of arboretum at Kew Gardens, said: "We have been using these for some years. They really are the best invention since the flowerpot."







UK plans to restrict personal tax allowance for non-residents

The UK government is considering another tax reform which could affect British expatriates, depending on your circumstances. Following on from its plan to charge non-UK residents capital gains tax on the sale of UK residential property, it is now considering whether to withdraw the personal tax allowance from non-UK residents, unless they have a strong economic connection in the UK.

Under current rules, UK nationals are entitled to the UK personal allowances whether they are resident in the UK or abroad. At the moment the first £10,000 of income is tax free, expected to increase to £10,500 from next April. It is also granted to many foreign non-residents, especially where their country has a tax treaty with the UK, for example, EU nationals working in the UK for a short time.

Most other countries, particularly most of the EU, the US, Australia and Canada, restrict entitlement to their own personal allowances. The UK therefore collects less tax on the income of non-residents than comparable jurisdictions.

The government first announced its intention to consult on restricting this allowance in the March budget and the Treasury

has now published its consultation document, "Restricting non-residents' entitlement to the UK personal allowance".

HM Revenue & Customs estimate that at least 400,000 individuals who are non-resident for tax purposes claim personal allowances and it costs the exchequer approximately £400 million a year.

The Treasury now proposes to restrict the availability of the allowance to non-residents, so that entitlement will be based on the economic connection the individual has with the UK.

Economic connection is likely to be measured by looking at what percentage of the individual's worldwide income arises in the UK. Many other countries use this test and the percentage is generally between 75% and 90%. So, if the percentage of your income arising in the country meets the set amount you are eligible for the allowance.

The UK government has expressed that because of the low administrative burden this method places on individuals, it is the preferred option. It wants to ensure that individuals with strong economic connections to the UK continue to benefit from the generous personal allowance.

The Treasury consultation document explains that although the loss of the UK personal allowance would mean non-residents would face increased UK tax liabilities, most of them would be able to claim relief overseas either in the form of a credit for tax paid in the UK or exemption from tax in their home state.

Most people would therefore not generally pay more tax overall than they do now, though this will depend on the relative level of tax rates and allowances between the UK and their country of residence - those living in low tax jurisdictions are likely to pay more tax. This is an important element for expatriates living in Cyprus because of the tax regime here.

Are you affected?

The consultation document looks at the impact on groups of people.

Retirees - Most retired British expatriates would not be affected. Tax treaty provisions generally mean that UK state pensions, personal or private sector occupational pensions are only taxable in recipient's states of residence. While government service pensions are usually only taxable in the UK, under the Cyprus/UK double tax treaty they are only taxable here in Cyprus. If you have other income which is taxable in the UK, you could be affected by losing your allowance.

Non-resident landlords - The consultation document says that these individuals are generally taxed on their UK rental income in their country of residence as well as the UK and can claim double taxation relief. However, since there is little or no tax liability to claim against in Cyprus, individuals renting UK property are likely to pay more tax overall.

High income individuals already have their personal allowances tapered away by virtue of their high income.

Middle income individuals - Depending on where they live, they may already claim double tax relief in their country of residence against any UK tax suffered. However, those in lower tax jurisdictions than the UK - such as Cyprus - would probably face a loss.

Low income individuals - To avoid administrative burden and tax losses to these individuals, the government intends to put a *de minimislimit* in place.

At this stage this is only a consultation, so there are no changes to the personal allowance yet. The timing of the consultation means that the earliest something can happen is Budget 2015, although Budget 2016 is more likely.

Having said that, this is a good time for those with UK source income to re-consider their position, particularly if you own and rent out property in the UK. Until now, provided you are non-UK resident for five years, you do not pay UK capital gains tax when selling UK assets - but from next April non-residents disposing of UK residential property will start being charged UK tax on the gains. In Cyprus, capital gains are only payable on gains arising on disposal of real estate located in Cyprus, so if you sell a UK property, you do not have to pay tax here.

As an expatriate living here in Cyprus, you need to understand how UK tax and changes there, could continue to affect you. Importantly, you also need to understand interaction of UK tax with Cyprus tax and ensure you are not missing out on

opportunities to save tax.

Investing in water

According to UN-Water.org, water use has been growing at more than twice the rate of population increase in the last century. It is predicted that by 2025, 1.8 billion people will be living in countries or regions with absolute water scarcity and two-thirds of the world population could be under stress conditions. The reasons for wanting to invest in water therefore make sense. Next to air, it is the world's most precious resource in supporting life. Water scarcity is also cited as a likely reason for future geopolitical conflicts. The thing about water is that, unlike with oil or natural gas, investors cannot bet on its price using futures contracts, ie no speculator can corner the market in water. Also, water utilities are subject to regulation and as water gets scarcer they could be slapped with price controls or usage limits. They are also sensitive to rising interest rates because utilities are favoured for their high income when rates are low.

The only practical way to invest in the water theme is to buy industrial companies that conserve, purify and treat water, as well as those that make equipment and deliver new technologies to the water industry. The strategy has performed well recently with water ETFs returning more than 4.8% in August, beating the S&P 500's 4.3% and have attracted just short of \$2 billion in assets since their inception in the mid-2000s. In terms of investment logic, water may be the ultimate long-term play - until an air ETF crops up! To illustrate how a water exchange traded fund (ETF) works, below is a summary of the Powershares one. The majority of its holdings are in industrials, with a smaller amount in utilities. Unlike a managed fund which can carry annual fees of around 1.5%, this ETF like most, carry a significantly lower annual charge of approx. 0.6%.

PowerShares Water Resources Portfolio (PHO)

This is the largest water ETF with \$980 million in assets. It holds US companies making products designed to conserve and purify water for homes, business and industries. The ETF has 66% in industrial stocks, 17% in utilities and a small amount in health care, technology and materials companies. Its portfolio is weighted by the market capitalization of its stocks and the top 10 holdings make up 60% of the portfolio. The top three stocks are Roper Industries Inc, Waters Corp and Flowserve Corp.

With stock markets at a general high point in the cycle, equity investors need to look further afield for returns and should look for certain themes that offer long term growth prospects. Water is

Market recap

It has been a particularly volatile period in the currency markets over the last month as the European Central Bank (ECB) surprised investors, the UK panicked over the Scottish referendum and speculation over the timing of rate rises in the US intensified.

Early in the month we saw the ECB surprise markets by cutting the benchmark interest rate from 0.25% to 0.15%, but also becoming the first major Central Bank to introduce negative interest rates. Further, and quite likely ofmore significance was the announcement of a stimulus programme to help the eurozone economies. Full details of this programme will be publicised after the ECB's next meeting (02.10.2014), but many analysts are saying that it is likely to be too little too late. Meanwhile, in the UK, the pound entered the spotlight, hypersensitive to news surrounding the Scottish referendum and opinion polls changing on a daily basis. With a 'yes' vote, at the time, being a realistic possibility the pound lost significant ground in the market. Sterling made some of the biggest intraday losses versus the euro and dollar in 13 months as investors braced themselves for the prospect of Britainbreakup and potentially a far larger drop in the value of the currency. With the actual result being "No" for independence, we did see the pound reverse those losses and strengthen across the board, touching a two-month high against the euro. With so much uncertainty in the markets for the euro and UK sectors, the US Dollar has been the main beneficiary, in part due to attention being focused elsewhere, but also with increased speculation that the Federal Reserve will increase interest rates sooner than many expect. Much of the data releases in the US have started to shed a positive light on the economy, and the Federal Reserve itself noted that investors have priced in a lower trajectory for interest rate rises than members of the Fed itself.

Looking ahead

With the Scottish referendum out of the way the euro will likely steal back the spotlight with attention focusing on the stimulus programme from the ECB. Although the size of the potential boost of €700 billion is huge it may not be enough to help Europe escape stagnation and so the ECB may also look to an unspoken policy of devaluing the euro in a bid to aid any potential recovery. Some analysts have predicted that this devaluing could be as much as 10%. The euro has also been


adversely affected by the continuing impact of sanctions placed both by the EU and US against Russia. Russia, by way of retaliation, has limited trading with the EU, causing losses to eurozone businesses and these factors give a current longer term view of a weaker euro.

Meanwhile the UK and US will continue their interest rate race and markets will look for further clues as to when any rise may happen. Bank of England governor, Mark Carney, has of late suggested that this could be as early as next spring so any further comments will be seized upon. The language used by the Federal Reserve is also likely to evolve at some point to reflect the data-dependent outlook. Although the Fed is unlikely to lay their cards on the table, investors frustrated by the lack of clarity may force some price action with markets favouring a stronger US Dollar moving forward.

November 2014. Is there any best time for him to do this, as the shares do have some value? Tom, Sea Caves

You may be aware that in the UK the sale of shares is subject to Capital gains tax. However, there is no Capital gains tax in the UK if you are not a UK resident. In Cyprus there is Capital gain tax only on gains arising from the sale of immovable property situated in Cyprus and shares in companies represented by immovable property situated in Cyprus. Therefore, the timing of the sale of his shares is critical. He needs to leave the UK before 5th April 2015, having agreed "a deal" but not having made it legally binding. The sale of the shares should be completed after 5th April 2015. The UK tax year runs from 6th April to 5th April. Therefore, he will be UK resident in the year to 5th April 2015 but will be non-resident in the UK for capital gain tax purposes from 6th April 2015. As the shares are to be legally sold say 10th April 2015 he will not be UK resident in the year the shares are sold and therefore there will be no UK Capital gains tax in the UK or Cyprus. Your brother must remain non-resident in the UK for five complete UK tax years.

If he becomes resident in the UK within five years then the UK gain will be chargeable to Capital gains tax in the tax year of his return. As all this is complicated I would suggest he seeks professional advice prior to him selling the shares. Clearly Read would be happy to have a meeting with him.

I have been living in Cyprus for four years in the same property and I am thinking of selling the property. What is the Capital gains tax position and are there any reliefs? Jenny, Peyia

The letter above confirms that in Cyprus Capital gains tax is chargeable on gains in respect of the sale of immovable property. The rate of the tax is 20%. There are allowances available for the disposal of principal private residence amounting to €85,500, disposal of agricultural land amounting to €25,650 and any other disposal of €17,100.These allowances can only be used once and any combination should not exceed €85,500. The allowance of €85,500 only applies where the owner has exclusively used the property for their own habitation for a total period of at least five years and situated on land not exceeding 1.5 hectare. The period of use of the residence does not necessarily have to be continuous.

The use may be interrupted, for example, during an absence overseas. The chargeable gain can be reduced by any capital losses made in the same year or from unrelieved capital losses brought forward from earlier years. As you have not lived there for five years you will only qualify for the €17,100 relief and therefore, I would advise you not to sell until you have exceeded the five years.

Why do dogs need massage?

For much the same reasons humans do!

your dog, however we ask you to keep quiet to minimize any distractions and to just watch the wonder of massage therapy do its work.

All massage therapy is undertaken with the dog off lead so that at all times your dog is free to move should (s)he choose to do so. We play background classical music, demonstrated in research studies as the type of music dogs find most relaxing (though how the dogs voted we are not quite sure!).

Owners and dogs are welcome to choose which massage oil they feel will be of most benefit.

Dog paw massage is often a favourite ending to the massage session. I guess having four doesn't lessen the impact of aching feet at the end of a long day!

Developing the art of dog massage during my training as a Guide Dog puppy trainer in the UK (where having a happy relaxed dog was fundamental to our training techniques), I have found dogs love massage at least as much as their owners, if not more, and we all appreciate that a chilled dog = a chilled owner.
